Kubb Set Grant Application

Grant Description: The U.S. National Kubb Championship Kubb Set Grant is aimed to promote kubb in new communities and/or with populations that currently are underrepresented in playing kubb in a specific community. These populations could include minorities, youth, persons with disabilities , elderly, etc. Free kubb sets will be sent to successful applicants. Applicants will need to show that the sets will be used in a way that will grow kubb and will also work towards sustained kubb activity in the community and/or with the new populations. The grant is a competitive grant, so the U.S. National Kubb Championship cannot guarantee that every applicant will be awarded sets. Unless there are exceptional circumstances, a maximum of two sets will be awarded for each application. The grant will not be awarded for sets to be used for personal use or solely for tournaments. A brief follow-up review will be required. The review will include a brief narrative that described the outcome of the use of the set(s) and photos.
